PROBLEM

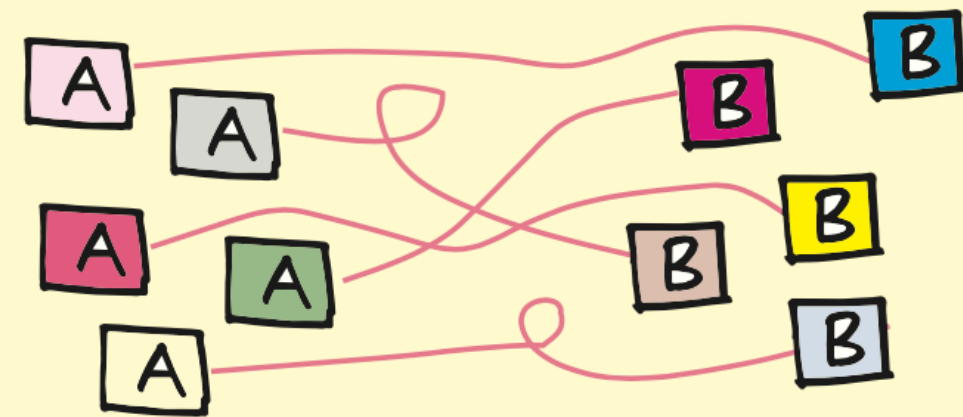
well-defined

Clear problem > different paths > one solution



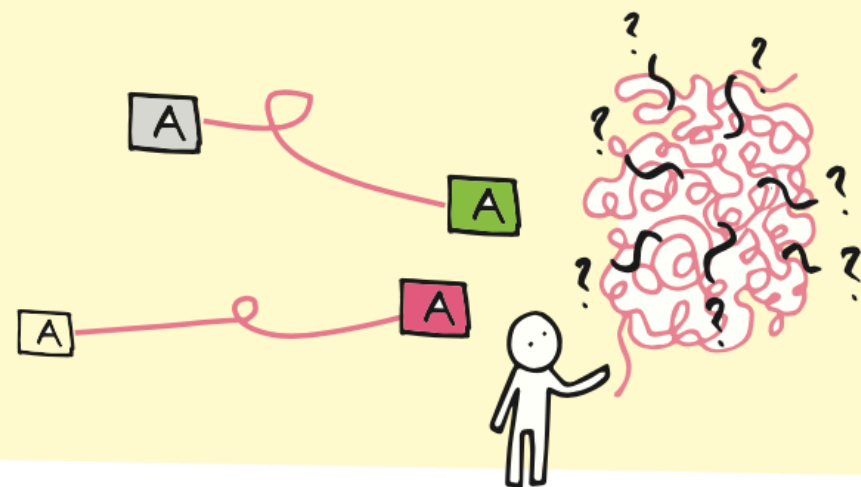
ill-defined

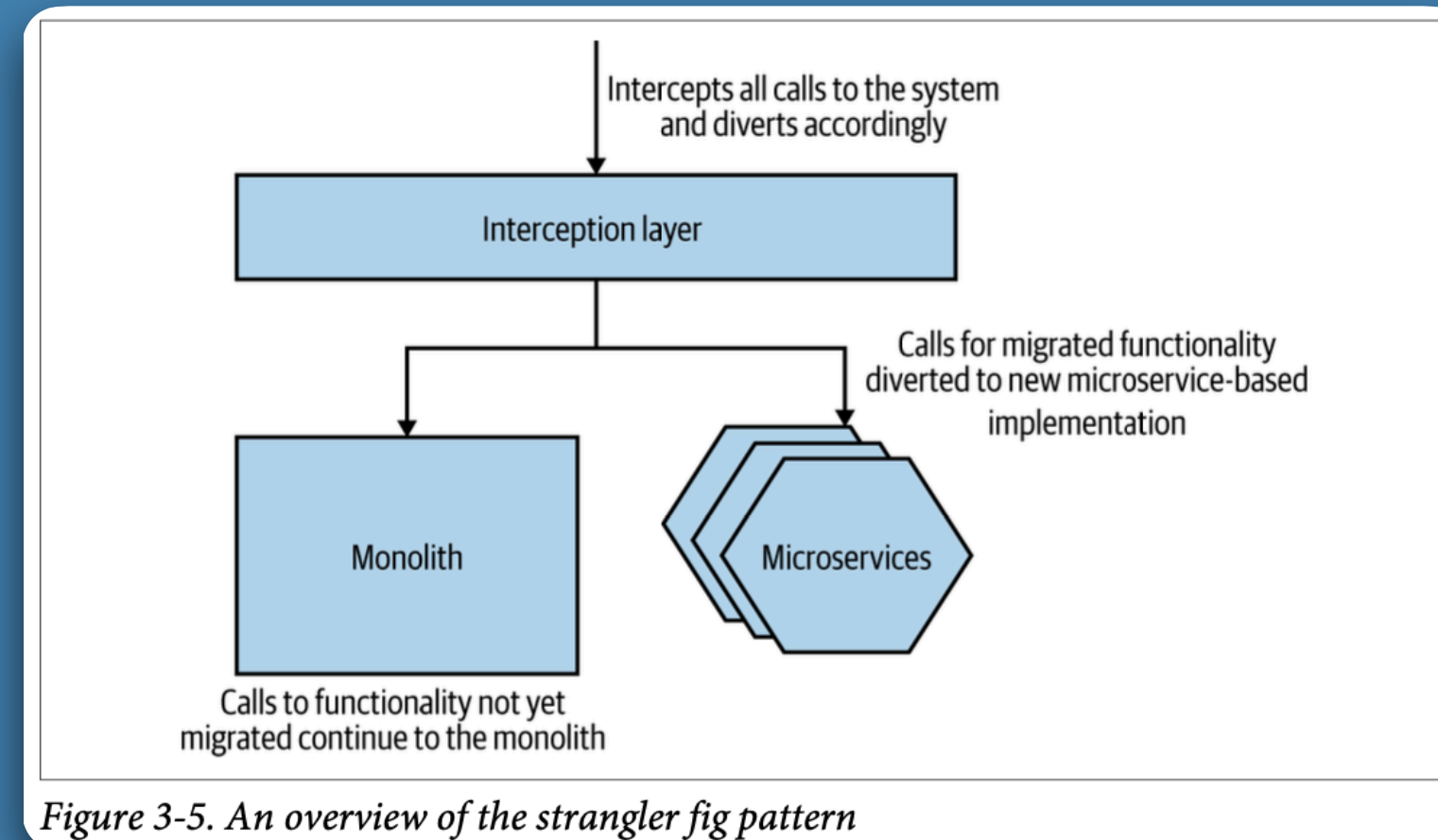


Figure 3-5. An overview of the strangler fig pattern

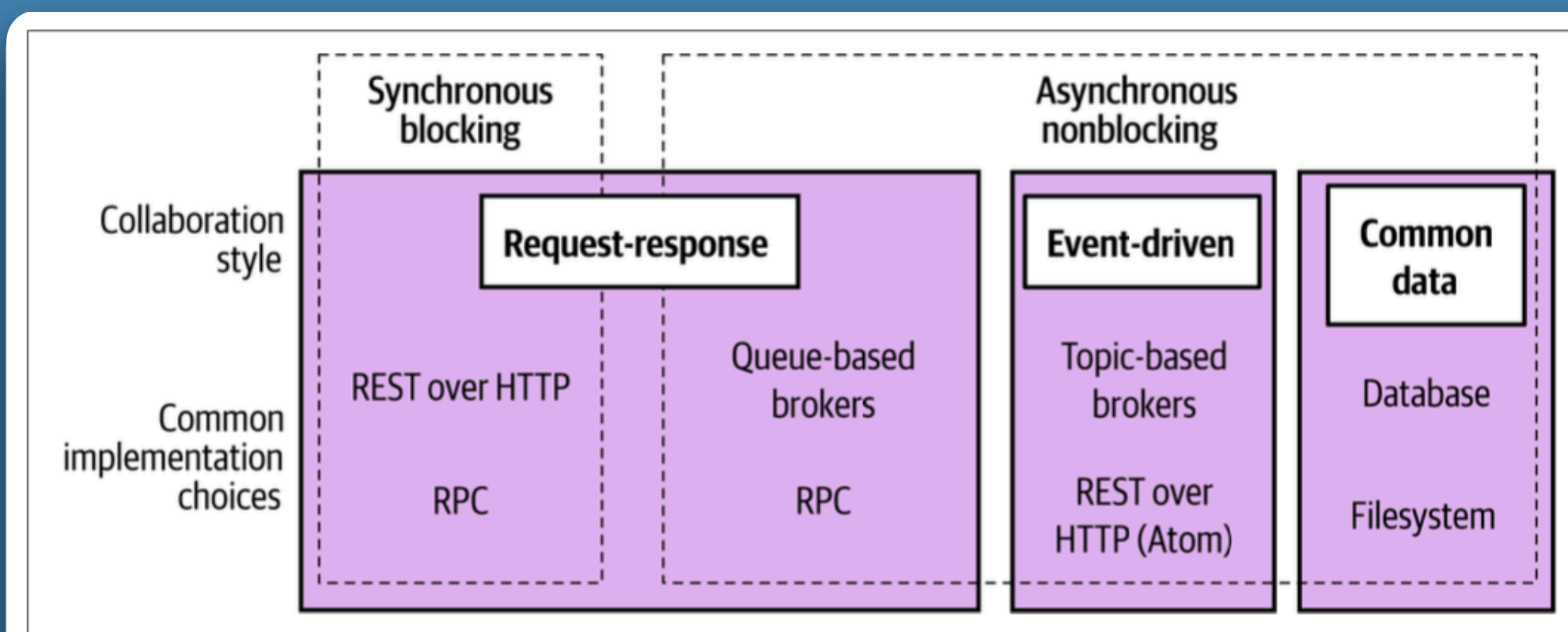


Figure 5-10. Different styles of inter-microservice communication, along with example implementing technologies

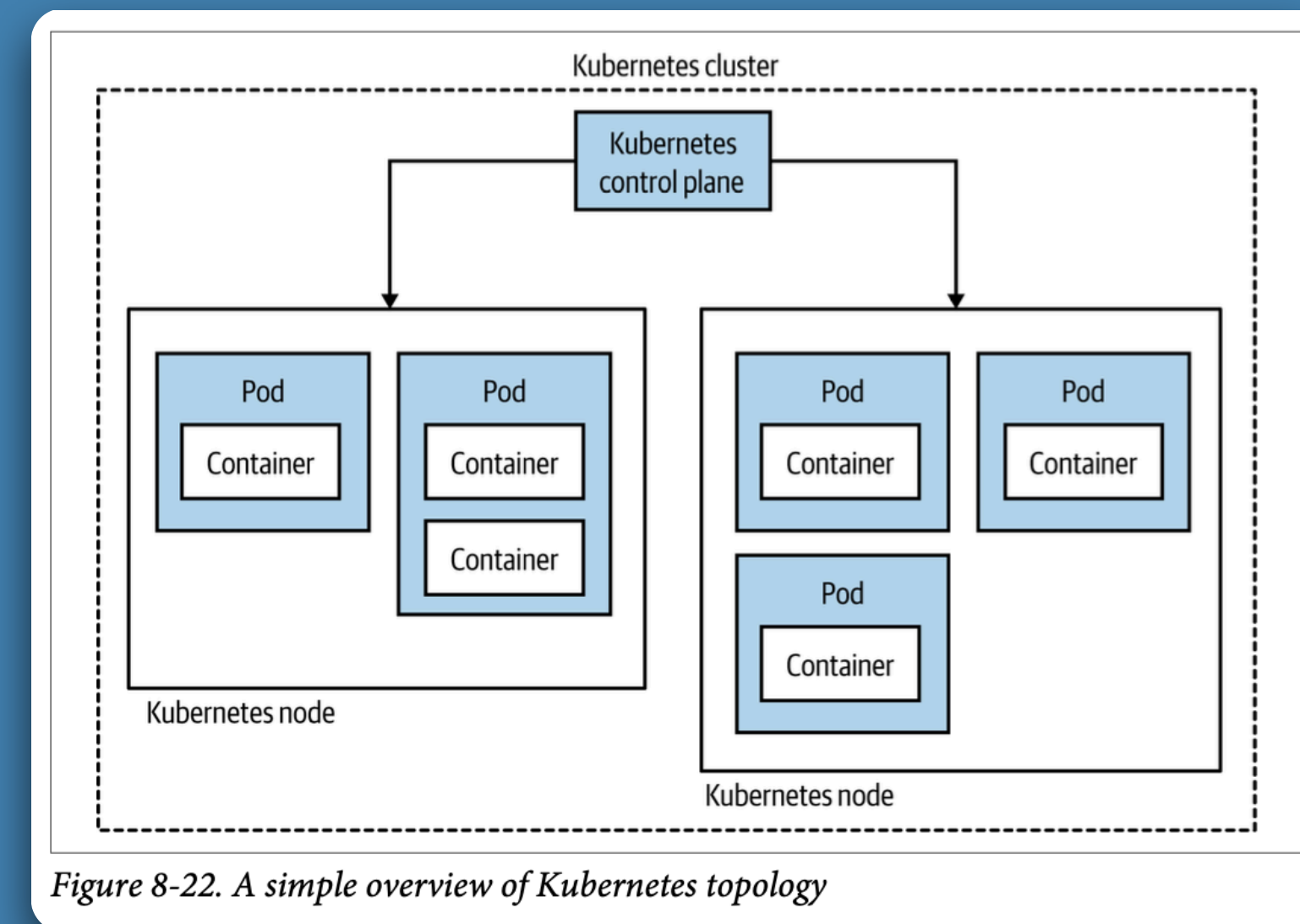


Figure 8-22. A simple overview of Kubernetes topology

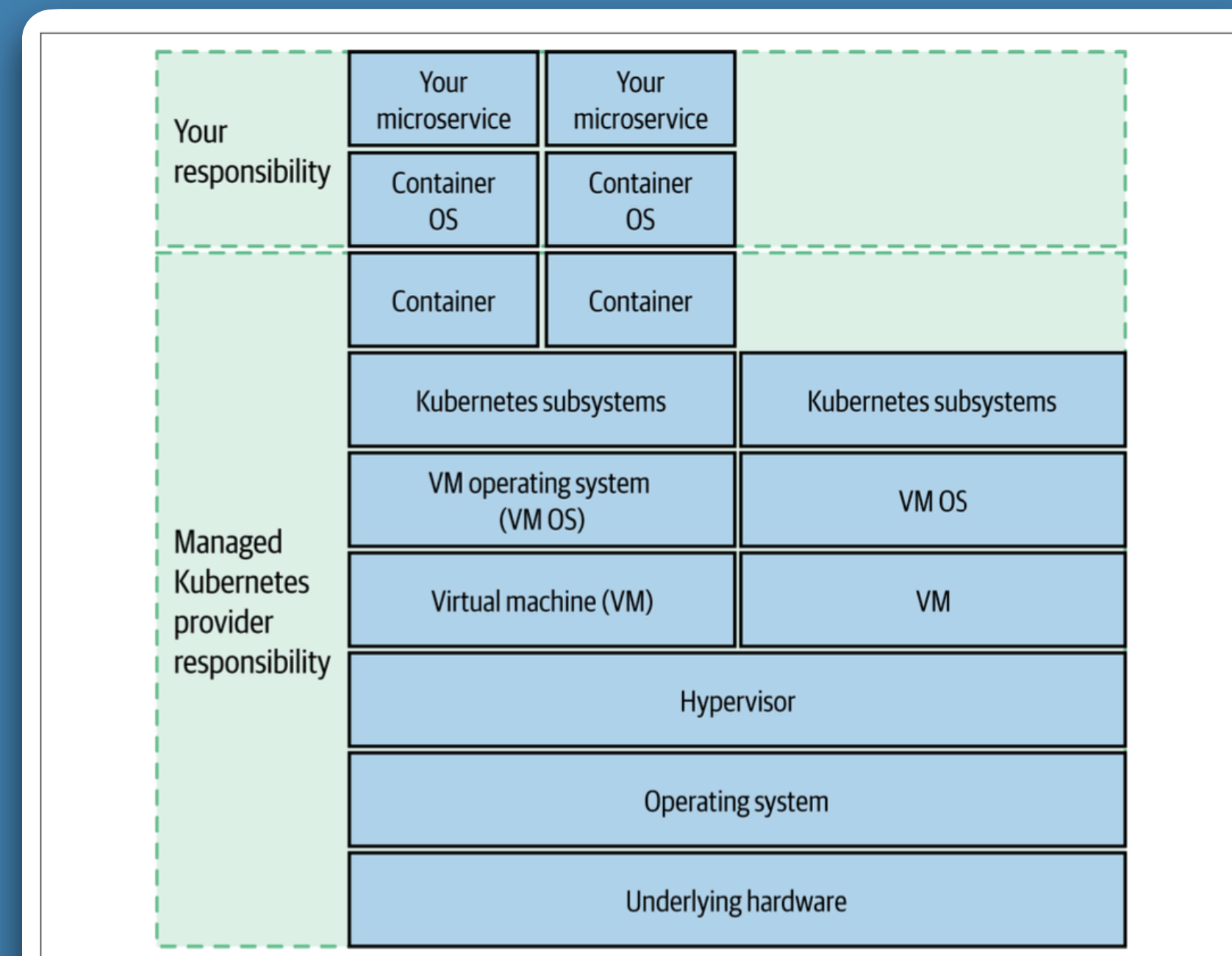


Figure 11-4. Offloading responsibility for some layers of this stack can reduce complexity
