## Wiki: Benefits

All team members can contribute.

A change made in one location is instantly visible in all other locations.

Pages and attachments are versioned!

Can serve as the system of record.

### Wiki: Drawbacks

Unrestricted access by all team members  
(some Wiki versions provide access control)

Free-form pages.

Limited markup for formatting.

### Instant Messengers

Instant connection between two or more parties.

Provide “presence.”

- » Presence is the feeling that one is not alone, but rather working together with the rest of the team that is currently online.

Can be set to “do not disturb.”

## Audio & Video Skype

Provide continuous connection through audio and video between two or more parties.

Can create the feeling that one is in the same office with the other person, because of the outstanding voice quality (at least within US).

1. The goals that you want to achieve
2. The roles you need to have to fulfill those goals
3. Identifying the knowledge you will need for the role
4. Devising a plan to obtain the knowledge
5. Seeking out experience to exercise your knowledge
